Meeting the link language requirement set out in the Service Minute and the Scheme of Recruitment

The officers with following qualifications should, without prejudice to any of the decision so far made, be released from the requirement of passing over the link language in the instance where the requirement of meeting the link language (English Language) has been stated in the Service Minutes and Schemes of Recruitment.

- Officers who have completed the degree/ post graduate degree in the medium of English.
- Officers who have passed the subject of English (not as an additional subject) at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination.
- Officers who have obtained a credit or a higher pass in the subject of English (not as an additional subject) at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.
- Officers who have sat for the examination for recruitment to service in the medium of English.


02. The Appointing Authority/ Administrative Authority should take action to release the public officer from the requirement of passing over the link language following a request made by the respective officer accompanied by the documents proving the above qualifications.
